SCA Chinese Heritage Club Board of Directors Meeting Tuesday, February 21, 2012 9:00 am - 12:00 pm At Penn Room Minutes

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 9 am.
- 2. Quorum was established with all board members present and with Peter Chin replacing Gilles Brisette. Members present were Celia Chang, Mary Ma, Lizwu Wu, and Tom Sulistio.
- 3. Minutes of January 17 were approved.
- 4. Reports from Officers and Directors
 - Financial Peter read Gilles Brisette's letter of resignation. He then welcomed Peter Chin whom the Board approved as the new Treasurer. He also reported that \$250 was refunded by the Activity Department to the club for the kitchen usage deposit.
 - Signatures on file at Wells Fargo bank were those of Peter Tu, Kitty, Claudette and Peter Chin.
 Peter Chin suggested that there be 2 accounts, Checking and Savings and that the Goodwill Fund
 be part of the Savings account. The question was asked about the use of petty cash. This money
 was for small expenditures under \$20 and did not need receipts for bookkeeping. At present,
 there was \$163.93 in the account.
 - Membership & Communications: Joe reported that there were 11 new members, making a total
 of 432. Members, Yu and Yen Lee, who were no longer residents or deceased will be removed
 from the list.
 - Joe wanted clarification on membership fees. The 2011 members were given membership for 2 years (2011& 2012). New members had to pay the 2012 fees. Joe will keep records of new member application forms and monies will be given to the treasurer.
 - The secretary will check the mail box at Anthem. Mail for specific members will be left in the mail box and that member will be informed of the delivery. Kitty will check mailbox this month since she has to be there for Mandarin classes.
 - Peter noted that Jeffrey Chang has been listed to run for SCA board. Joe will invite him to join our club.
 - Activity/Program: Grace introduced Tom Sulistio who will host the April 8th presentation. He will present his plan later in the meeting.
 - Ad Hoc: Diane related that April Spirit article is due by Friday, February 24. Kitty suggested that the Outreach presentation be included and she will send her photo of the Outreach performance. 5. Inputs from Activity Leaders & Members...How can the board help?
